## **APPROVAL CRITERIA**

Requests for Tyrvaya (varenicline tartrate) Nasal Solution may be approved if the following criteria are met:

Individual is 18 years of age or older;

## AND

- II. Individual is using to treat moderate to severe dry eye disease (AAO 2018); AND
- III. Individual had an abnormal result or response to one or more of the following dry eye disease diagnostic/assessment methods (AAO 2018):
  - A. Tear break-up time (less than 10 seconds); OR
  - B. Ocular surface dye staining using fluorescein, rose bengal, or lissamine green dyes;
    OR
  - C. Schirmer test (aqueous tear production of less than or equal to 10 mm of strip wetting in 5 minutes); **OR**
  - D. Fluorescein clearance test/tear function index; OR
  - E. Tear osmolarity (indicating tear film instability); **OR**
  - F. Tear lactoferrin concentrations in the lacrimal gland (decreased); **OR**
  - G. Matrix metalloproteinase-9 (MMP-9) test;

### **AND**

IV. Individual has had a trial (medication samples/coupons/discount cards are excluded from consideration as a trial) and inadequate response or intolerance to Xiidra (lifitegrast ophthalmic solution);

#### OR

V. Individual has a known hypersensitivity to any ingredient in Xiidra which is not also present in the requested non-preferred agent (Tyrvaya).
